**Canada~Snowboard Coaching Program (CSCP)
Evaluations in British Columbia**

With the CSCP/NCCP push to have Comp Intro (former Basic Coach) coaches evaluated and eventually certified within three years of attending their course, BC has taken the following approach to assist in the certification process for coaches.

1. Identify and train club representatives to effectively mentor their coaches and assist them in gaining CSCP Certified status
2. Explaining the process and how it will affect you and your coaches

Monday November 28th the CSCP will be hosting an evaluator workshop in Whistler, BC, and December 19th at Big White. Club representatives and coaches from across the region are invited to participate in the workshop to ensure we can achieve the goal of coach certification in BC. At this workshop attendees will be given the tools required to certify a coach at the Comp Intro (former Basic Coach) level, as well as an opportunity to ask questions and understand the certification process.

At present there is no monetary compensation for evaluators. The process is based around an effective mentorship program. A coach who has completed the CSCP Comp Intro Advanced or Comp Dev course needs to mentor one or more Comp Intro coaches to assist them in completing their portfolio and taking them through the evaluation process. In order to successfully implement this program we are calling on the clubs to take charge and help their coaches through the process.

Participating in the evaluation process will help improve the quality of your coaching programs, allow the coaches of your program to obtain their certification status to retain their coaching licence and allow you to complete a portion of your Comp Intro Advanced or Comp Dev portfolio requirements (mentor a coach).

With the number of programs and the demands of the coaching season, this is the most logical approach to achieve certification of Comp Intro coaches. If you are interested in this process please register for the course on the Canada Snowboard website.

For any of your coaches requiring training there are three Comp Intro Courses running in BC in early winter.

November 29th - Dec 2nd - Whistler
December 21st - 23rd - Big White
January 9th - 11th - Mt Washington
Sun Peaks (TBA)
