SPEED NATION Panorama SBX (NorAm)

Speed Nation Panorama is the 1st Snowboardcross stop of the Speed Nation SBX NorAm Tour.

Speed Nation Panorama brings together the best snowboardcross athletes in North America to compete in 2 Snowboardcross events over three days; January 7-9, 2019.

THE RESORT

Panorama Mountain Resort is situated in BC's Purcell Mountains, with alpine views to the Rocky Mountains. The nearest major city is Calgary, AB, just a 3½ hour drive away.

Access from Calgary is west, via Highway 1 through the Banff and Kootenay National Parks, followed by a turn south on Highway 93 through to Radium and onwards to Invermere, BC.

From Invermere, a gentle 20 minute drive rises into the Purcell Mountains and winds towards Panorama Mountain Resort.

REGISTRATION FEES

Registration Fees for the Speed Nation Panorama SBX are

- \$135 for one (1) competition day ([Online Registration](#))
- \$150 for one (1) competition day (Onsite)
- \$270 for two (2) competition days ([Online Registration](#))
- \$300 for two (2) competition days (Onsite).

Athlete/Coach Sign In

All participating athletes and coaches are required to Sign In at the Event Office, to confirm registration and to complete mandatory Panorama Special Event Waivers.

Note: Panorama Special Event Waivers must be signed in person by participant and, if required, by parent or legal guardian (coach) for athletes under 19.

Lift Tickets

- Athletes: Lift Tickets for competition days will be offered at 25% discount
Vouchers will be provided at Sign In.
- Coaches: Lift Tickets will be comped based on 5 athletes to 1 coach pass.
Coaches not qualifying for comp pass will receive 25% discount voucher.

REFUND POLICY

Any refund of Event Registration Fee requires the approval BC Snowboard Association Executive Director.

Request for refund must be submitted by email to: bcsnow@telus.net

The following are viable reasons for permitting Event Registration Fee refunds:

- Event cancellation or date/location changes
- Injury sustained prior to event training, preventing participation in event (must be confirmed with doctor's note)
- Exceptions: hardship special circumstances require the prior approval of BC Snowboard Associations Executive Director

Refunds for cash or cheque transactions must be refunded by cheque.
Credit card refunds must be processed via card transaction credit.

Membership, SAIP Insurance and FIS license fees are not refundable.
Lift Tickets are not refundable.
