2018 Provincial Series: Overall Points Calculation Policy **December 15, 2017**

Introduction

The 2018 BC Snowboard Provincial Series – RIDE ON Snowboard Series calendar consists of Snowboard Cross (SBX) and Slopestyle (SS) events. The BC Snowboard Provincial Series calendar can be found at http://www.bcsnowboard.com/events/provincial-events/.

NOTE: For 2018 the Provincial Finals are divided into 2 Western Championships Slopestyle at COP, AB – Event Notice for March 3 and 4, 2018 Snowboard Cross at Big White, BC – Event Notice for March 16-18, 2018

Slopestyle events have the following categories or groups (Male / Female):

Overall (Canadian Ranking List Points)

FIS

U13 (12 and under) - awarded from a sort of the Overall results

U15 (13 and 14) - awarded from a sort of the Overall results

U19 (15 to 18) - awarded from a sort of the Overall results

19+ (19 and over) – awarded from a sort of the Overall results

Snowboard Cross events have the following categories or groups (Male / Female)

U13 (12 and under) - awarded from Heats consisting of this group

U15 (13 and 14) - awarded from Heats consisting of this group

U19 (15 to 18) – awarded from Heats consisting of this group

19 + (19 and over) - awarded from Heats consisting of this group)

Provincial Series Points

Overall Provincial Series Points are used to identify BC athletes for:

- Canada Snowboard Nationals Championships
- Provincial Teams
- BC Winter Games
- Canada Winter Games
- Canada West All Areas Pass distribution

Overall Prizing

Overall prize money will be provided to the top BC athletes (Male and Female) in the FIS SBX and Overall SS categories, provided they attend the 2018 Canadian National Championships, in the amounts of:

\$300 for 1st | \$200 for 2nd | \$100 for 3rd

Eligibility

- The 2018 BC Snowboard Provincial Series events are open to all athletes with Provincial/Territorial Competitive memberships, and to international competitors. See eligibility on each Event Notice posted here: http://www.bcsnowboard.com/events/event-notices-registration/
- 2. Overall Series Points are assigned to all participating athletes.
- 3. To be eligible to earn FIS points (www.fis-ski.com) an athlete must hold a current and valid FIS license and SAIP Insurance.
- 4. An athlete can participate in more than one discipline.

Note: Provincial/Territorial Advanced Competitor License, Sport Athlete Insurance Program (SAIP) and FIS license can be purchased online at www.bcsnowboard.goalline.ca.

Assignment of Points ("Assigned Points")

1. Overall Provincial Series Points are assigned to the Event result in each discipline by gender and group, using the 50 point scale from the FIS points rule book, as follows:

Results and Ranking

- 1. An athlete's Overall Provincial Series Points are the average of his/her best two (2) Assigned Points in one discipline by gender and group.
- 2. Eligible athletes shall be ranked in the Overall Provincial Series Points according to the highest score by gender and group per discipline.
- 3. Overall Provincial Series Results for different disciplines are not added together and are maintained separately for each discipline.

Tie Breaking

- 1. In the event of a tie in the Overall Provincial Series Ranking, the single highest Assigned Points score will be used to break the tie.
- 2. Should a tie continue to exist, the next best Assigned Points score will be used to break the tie.
