

# **BC Snowboard Judging Clinic Penticton - November 16, 2025**

## Get Certified to Judge Events Across BC and Beyond

Join us for a full-day snowboard judging clinic designed for aspiring judges, former competitive riders and coaches looking to deepen their involvement in the sport. This clinic will cover both the WSF (World Snowboard Federation) and FIS (International Ski and Snowboard Federation) judging standards, offering participants the opportunity to qualify as certified judges for BC Snowboard Provincial Series events, NorAm-level competitions, and local grassroots events.

Running from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, the course will include a mix of theory, judging protocol, practical video judging sessions and discussion. We'll focus on key freestyle disciplines including Big Air, Halfpipe, Slopestyle, and Rail Jam formats. Instruction will be delivered through a detailed PowerPoint presentation, group discussions, and hands-on judging exercises using real event footage.

Participants should bring a notebook, pen or pencil, and pack a lunch and snacks for the day.

Whether you're looking to stay connected to the sport or take your coaching knowledge to the next level, this clinic is the perfect way to get involved in shaping the next generation of snowboarding talent.
