## THE RESORT

<u>Sun Peaks</u> is a resort community located 45 minutes from Kamloops, in BC's interior. Known for its stressfree mountain experience, the charming pedestrian village includes <u>hotels and lodges</u>, and over 40 locallyowned <u>shops</u> and <u>restaurants</u>.

Sun Peaks is Canada's second largest ski area with 4,270 acres of diverse ski terrain. But it is not just for winter enthusiasts. Sun Peaks has activities throughout the year.

Sun Peaks can be accessed by two airport gateways - Kamloops (45 minutes) and Kelowna (2.5 hours) and also by car; only a four-hour drive separates Sun Peaks and Vancouver, B.C.

This past summer Sun Peaks embarked on a major project to build their snow cross course on Sundance Mountain permanently from dirt, in partnership with Powder Ventures Excavations, a local company operating for 25 years and deeply committed to the community. Competitors must be 15 years of age as of December 31, 2024. Competitors must hold a valid FIS License prior to the first Team Captains Meeting scheduled for this Event.

Coaches: Lift Tickets will be comped based on 5 athletes to 1 coach pass. Coaches not qualifying for comp pass will receive 50% discount.
