Competitors MUST hold a current FIS License in order to compete and MUST be at least 15 years of age as of December 31, 2021.

Waivers

All participating athletes and coaches MUST sign the Big White Special Event Waiver.

Lift Tickets

Athletes: Lift Tickets for training and competition days will be offered at 50% discount. Tickets will be purchased at Guest Services.

Coaches: Lift Tickets will be comped based on 5 athletes to 1 coach pass. Coaches not qualifying for comp pass will receive the 50% discount.
